



Supporting the Warfighter remains our top priority

- ✓ We Can't Repeat Mistakes of the Past
- ✓ Continuous Process Improvement will Not Result in Sufficient Efficiencies...Must Continue to Reduce the Cost of Doing Business.
- ✓ Must Have Automation and Linked Business Systems
- ✓ Must Ensure Unimpeded Networks
- ✓ Increase Use of Public / Private Partnerships
- ✓ Teamwork is Absolute – DLA, TRANSCOM, Other Services, Industry, and Academia
- ✓ Develop Critical New Capabilities and Innovate the next Generation of Capabilities
- ✓ Must ensure Readiness

$$\text{Readiness} = \frac{\text{Mean Time Between Failure (MTBF)}}{\text{MTBF} + \text{Mean Logistics Delay Time} + \text{Mean Time to Repair}}$$

- ✓ Science and Technology (S&T): Invest in S&T to enable next generation capabilities
